at the presence of their delegations sign the present **MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT**

they **RECOGNISE** by this Act , that cultural exchange made in the days April 30 , 1 and 2 May 2016 funded by the European Union within the Europe for Citizens program, has created a positive relationship between communities.

The administrators of Santarcangelo, Krasne and Sibenik, **UNDERTAKE** to promote, by all possible means, the development of collaboration between the respective communities, in the knowledge that the mutual exchange of experiences, in a world of increasingly globalization, will be an enrichment for the citizens they represent, for those of today and those of tomorrow.

The directors of the three cities finally **AGREE** to promote the common themes discussed in the above three days: the economy and finance after the crisis, the value of reuse, recovery of peasant memory as a prospect for the new generations of European citizens.
